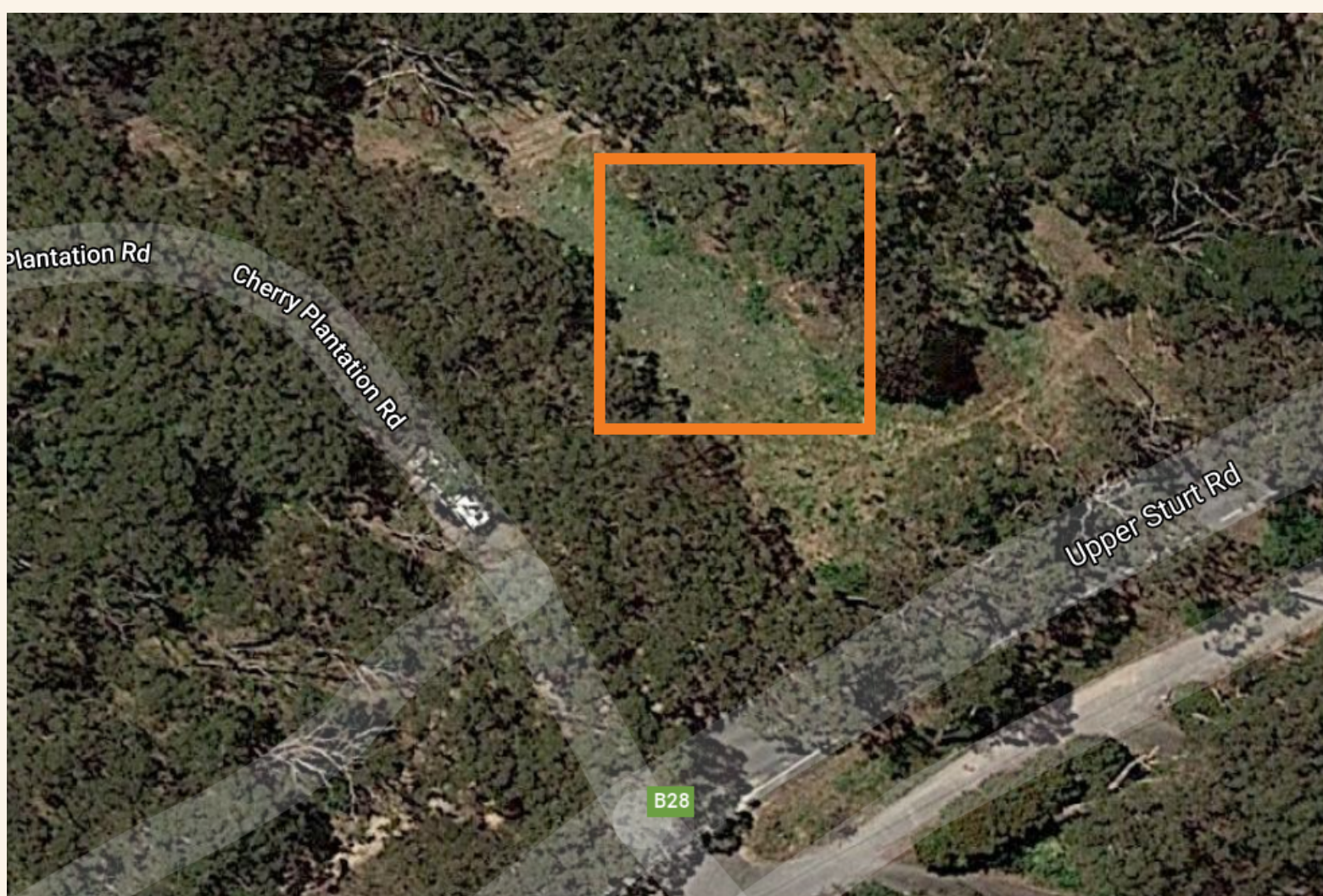
Mercy Grove, Belair National park
