Today's Theme: "CORPUS CHRISTI"

Corpus Christi, arose in 13th century Belgium in response to debated about the real presence and as a result of an upsurge in eucharistic piety. The feast celebrates the mystery of the nourishing and enduring presence of the body and blood of Christ in the Eucharist.

Antiphon: He fed them with the finest wheat and satisfied them with honey from the rock.

Response to the Psalm: You are a priest for ever, in the line of Melchizedek.

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! I am the living bread from heaven, says the Lord; whoever eats this bread will live for ever. Alleluia!

Communion Antiphon: Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him, says the Lord.

Dear Parishioners,

This week – here in St. Paul's - the Provincial Council met for what we call a 'consulta' (a meeting of our 'board of directors'). As the term suggests the meeting is one where the Provincial 'consults' his four council members over a series of issues and seeks advice (and sometimes a vote of approval) for various actions and initiatives.

This meeting, we focused on plans for our next Provincial Chapter (now only 12 months away), which will involve men gathering from Vietnam, PNG, NZ and Australia to plan our common future. As I have mentioned before, the youngest members of the Province are in Vietnam and Papua New Guinea whilst the older men are Australians and New Zealanders. As each group and country have vastly different needs, we must carefully balance our future personnel placement, apostolic initiatives, and financial resources. Our planning must also carefully balance future needs with present requirements, missionary outreach with pastoral care of our own members and formation of the young with health and life-style care of our elderly members.

Our Provincial Chapter will be in Sydney in July 2023 and our formal preparations will begin next month.

Also, next month our province will celebrate 100 years of independence from our foundation province (the Anglo-Hibernian province of England, Ireland, Scotland). I will write more about this event next week.

You will also read today in our bulletin of the Art Show to be held here in the monastery in July. This will be held on the first weekend in July and will feature artwork from the children of St Raphael's School – our parish school. Please make some time to visit over this weekend to see the public exhibition. The art works will be on display on Friday 1 July from 4:00pm-8:00pm, Saturday 2 July from 10:00am-1:00pm and Sunday 3 July from 10:00am- 1:00pm.

Finally, please join with me in congratulating the 22 children who were confirmed last Tuesday and pray with them as they make their First Holy Communion this Sunday on the Feast of Corpus Christi. Our thanks go to Sue Schulz our Pastoral Associate who coordinated the preparation program and the ceremonies, to our School APRIM Kelly Manera and to the families that hosted preparation groups for making all this possible.
