Dear Parishioners,

In 2020, the beginning of the celebrations of the 300th anniversary of the founding of the Passionist Congregation, the Passionists commissioned an Icon of St Paul of the Cross to be 'written'. (Artists technically do not paint an Icon, since it is a religious activity to create one, they are said to 'write' it – a process that involves fasting, prayer and reflection over the many months it takes to prepare an Icon).

The Icon was then sent to every part of the world and has been displayed in the monasteries and churches of the sixty-one countries that the Passionists work within. At long last, after many delays caused principally by the Covid pandemic, the Icon has arrived in Adelaide and will be available to our parish for a time now. We are most privileged in that we will have the Icon with us for the parish celebrations and Feast of St Paul of the Cross on October 19th.

Accompanying the Icon is also a first-class Relic of the Saint. This too will be on display and will be used also for blessings for those who wish to receive one.

Covid denied us the chance to welcome the Icon during the official days of the Jubilee, but we receive it joyfully now. It's arrival also coincides with the 100th anniversary of the Passionists in Australia becoming an independent entity called a *province*, so we do have some jubilee element in hosting the Icon now.

We will display the Icon in each of our Mass centres (including Lourdes Valley), and it will be available at the times of our Masses as well as being a focus for private prayer. The icon is in the form of a triptyc and features St. Paul of the Cross and other prominent Passionist figures, including St. Gabriel Possenti, Blessed Dominic Barberi, St. Gemma Galgani and Blessed Isidore De Loor.

The schedule of times and locations, and an explanation of the Icon and Relic will be available at the entrances to our churches.

Let us use this time as one for renewal of our prayerful devotion and bring before our Patron Saint the intentions of our hearts.
