### Advent Series of reflections

The Eucharist is Jesus' own gift to us, a time to gather around his table so that we can celebrate the memorial of his life, death and resurrection, where we too can give praise and thanks to God our Father, where we can unite ourselves to Jesus' own sacrifice and where the Spirit can transform us more and more into the Body of Christ so that we might continue the mission of Jesus in our world today. I will focus on one part of the Eucharist each week.
