#### “CHRIST'S ETERNAL GLORY”

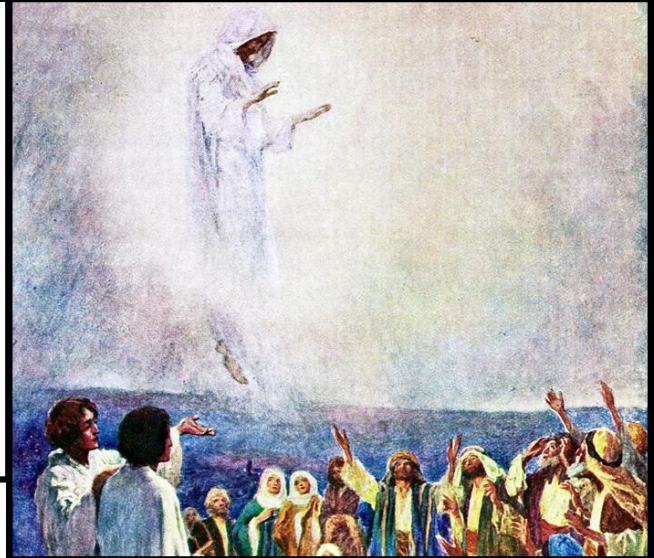

### VOICE TO PARLIAMENT REFERENDUM WEBINAR SERIES

### HOMELESSNESS AND HOUSING AFFORDABILITY WEDNESDAY 24 MAY 2023 AT 7:30 PM

According to the Australian Human Rights Commission, every night, roughly 1 in 200 Australians find themselves without a safe, secure or affordable place to sleep. The 2011 and 2016 census data reflect that same rate of homelessness, suggesting the problem in Australia has become intractable. Fifty-one countries have a lower rate of homelessness than Australia's.

Peter Sandeman AM, Anglican Canon for Social Justice and Advocacy, Adjunct Professor UniSA Business, and former CEO of AnglicareSA will discuss the issue as a whole.

While hosted by St Chad's Anglican Church, speakers are selected for their experience and / or expertise, not to represent the position of the Anglican Church in Australia.
