### ONE JOURNEY, TOGETHER

The National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Catholic Council (NATSICC) has launched a new website called 'One Journey, Together' for Catholics to learn about the Indigenous Voice to Parliament.

The website hosts stories and anecdotes from Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities and organisations, Catholic organisations and identities.

Darwin Bishop Charles Gauci said: "As Australians we are at a very important time reflecting on the Voice to Parliament. I will not tell anyone how to vote, but it is my responsibility as Bishop to encourage you all to be reflective in the light of our faith and Catholic Social Teachings: The Common Good and the Dignity of all People."

NATSICC chairperson John Lochowiak, said: "We are proud to be Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander and we are proud to be Catholic. Our shared faith calls on us to come together as one to uphold justice, and I encourage Catholics to take a look at the website and learn more about how they can engage in this important referendum."

NATSICC has issued a statement expressing its support for the Voice to Parliament, acknowledging that the Voice represents "a significant stride towards empowering Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples in addressing the deep-seated inequities prevalent in numerous social, economic and health indicators".
