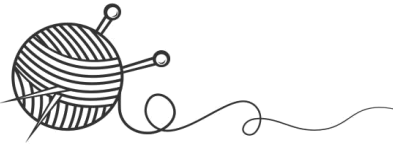
PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL MEETING
