DETAILS FOR THE DAY:

Bookings

Please be aware, at our busiest of times, we may ask people in line to lead groups and there may be a wait before entering. The Sacred Garden will remain open for the public until 6:00pm.

Donations

We do not charge an entry fee for Good Friday, however, we appreciate and rely on your donations to maintain our Sacred Garden.

Reconciliation

There will be Reconciliation with our Priests at the front of the building from 9:30am till 11:30am.

Children's Station of the Cross

The Children's Stations of the Cross will be open from 9:00am till 12:00pm. This will be held in and around our Memorial Garden again, weather permitting.

St Paul of the Cross Church

St Paul of the Cross Church will be open from 7:00am till 12:30pm. There will be a looped power point of the Stations for those who cannot walk around the garden. The Church will be closed at 12:30pm sharp so we can set up for Mass.

Coffee and Herb Bread

This year, there will be no coffee and herb bread offered in our Dining room

Good Friday Service

Commemoration of the Passion will be celebrated at 3pm on Good Friday at both St Paul's and St Raphael's.
