OUR CALLING

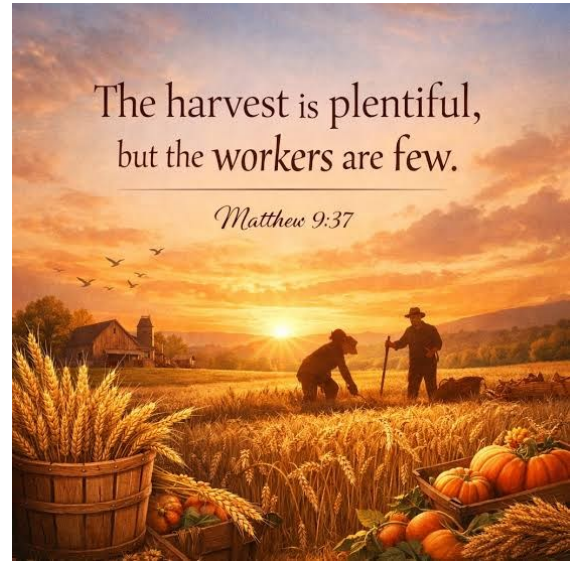

FAMILY GROUPS' 40TH ANNIVERSARY

This weekend at St Paul of the Cross Parish we are celebrating the 40th anniversary of the establishment of Family Groups.

Forty years ago the Passionist Family Group Movement which had begun interstate led by Fr Peter McGrath CP was introduced to South Australia, beginning at St Paul of the Cross Parish with the guidance and encouragement of Fr Denis Travers CP as Parish Priest, ably supported by our dear Brother Michael CP. The principle of the Family Group movement is simple – to encourage families and individuals to form groups and meet regularly for the on-going provision of mutual friendship and support.

The groups formed at that time were disparate in terms of age and make-up, including families, couples, and single people. The bulk were families, with children ranging from babies to teenagers and young adults, as well as grandparents.

After 40 years, the profile of the groups has changed, with many of the older members of the original groups having died, the children of the groups now adults with their own families, the introduction of new people to the groups, some groups ceasing to exist and new groups beginning. The original members are now forty years older, and that is reflected in the types of gatherings the groups now hold - where once there were hikes, picnics and weekends away with large groups of families, now people are more likely to meet for lunches in each other's homes or visits to the cinema and a coffee or lunch catch-up. There have always been phone calls to check on each other's well-being. A few years ago after a campaign for new members, again while Fr Denis was parish priest, we welcomed a new group composed of young families, many from overseas, to the mix. There are now nine groups of various sizes, the largest having twenty two members, going strongly in the parish.

Many members of these family groups are celebrating the 40th anniversary at the 10.30am Mass and gathering afterwards in the Monastery dining room for lunch. We are delighted to have Fr Denis with us from Sydney for the occasion.

We are grateful to the Passionist Family Group Movement and the St Paul of the Cross Parish for enabling the many years of strong and enduring relationships which have supported families and individuals through sharing the sorrows and joys of our changing lives.
